Dear Parents

On Friday, 5<sup>th</sup> September the parents of Year Three and Year Five students received their child's results for the National Assessment Program –Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) which they sat for on the 13<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2014. These results provide an account on how these students performed in Literacy and Numeracy on the day of the assessment. NAPLAN assesses aspects of literacy including; reading, spelling, punctuation and grammar and writing, as well as numeracy.

It is important to remember that NAPLAN is just one form of assessment used to determine the performance and progress of students. The Year Three test assesses concepts and skills learnt in Literacy and Numeracy from Kindergarten to Year Three. Similarly the Year Five test then assesses all learnings from each grade up to that point in time. In this type of test situation some children perform very well while others may be overwhelmed by the situation and not achieve the expected levels. At St Patrick's Parramatta **all** students in Years three and five sit for the NAPLAN tests.

Each NAPLAN report shows the child's achievement in skill bands; for Year three, Bands 1 to 6 and for Year five, Bands 3 to 8. The report also shows the national average and the school's average and allows parents to see how their child's performance compares to that of other students, across Australia, who sat for the tests. It is pleasing to note that the school average was above the national average in all areas in Literacy and Numeracy in both Years 3 and 5. Areas of particular strength include Persuasive Writing, Spelling and Grammar and Punctuation for both grades where the school's average was well above the national average. Although above the national average, an area for further development is Numeracy.

Teachers will now use the NAPLAN results to assist them to better understand the learning needs of their students and to take further action to improve their literacy and numeracy skills.

### CHILD PROTECTION

### Dear Parents,

If your child is having any difficulty at school eg social problems with other children, can I ask you to make an appointment to discuss this with your child's classroom teacher, ring Mrs Benkovich or myself. Under no circumstances is it appropriate for you to approach the other child to reprimand them, even in what you may think is in the gentlest of ways. Children are vulnerable and must always be protected and 'adult to child' interaction at school must always be nonthreatening and positive. In this way we can protect all children who have the right to feel safe at school, especially from adults. I can assure you that all incidents reported will be thoroughly followed up and actions taken until situations are resolved. In my experience children are often willing to forgive and forget within a reasonable time if managed properly by the adults involved. Once again please feel welcome to contact the school at any time for any concerns you may have.
