Dear Parents and Caregivers

Yesterday (17th March) we recalled the life of St Patrick, on the anniversary of his death in the year 387.

The life of the school's patron saint, St Patrick is such an interesting one and his association with the people of Ireland, combined with the enormous contribution the Irish convicts and settlers had on the establishment of the first colony, particularly Parramatta, makes him very significant to Catholics in Australia. Just like St Patrick, the early convicts and free men and women brought the Word of God to these early settlers. It is through these early Irish Catholics that the first Australian Church was established and from there the first Catholic Schools. St Patrick's School Parramatta is known to originate from the oldest Catholic School in Australia. What an honour to have such an illustrious history.

Did you know that the first Catholic school in Parramatta was on land owned by J.T. Campbell and was 25 Poles in size. The exact address is still unknown but we do know it existed in Parramatta. This is the location from which Catholic Education grew. (FYI: When used to measure area, a pole equals a square area 1 pole by 1 pole. When used to measure length, a pole equals 5.03 metres.

There are many St Patrick's Schools in Australia; in fact there are 28 St Patrick's Schools in New South Wales. Some of the suburbs which are served by a St Patrick's Schools include: Asquith, East Gosford, Port Kembla, Campbelltown, Straithfield, 2 in Sutherland, **Dundas**, Albury, Cooma, Bega, **Blacktown**, Brewarina, Cessnock, Griffith, **Guidlford**, Gundagai, Holbrook, Lithgow, Lochinvar, Macksville, Swansea, Trundle, Walcha, Wallsend, Kogarah, Summer Hill, and **Parramatta**. The highlighted schools are in the Parramatta Diocese. Our school is part of the St Patrick's Cathedral Parish Community.

One of the most beautiful prayers known is called the St Patrick's Breastplate. It is also the inspiration for the Hymn - A Deer's Cry




A Prayer of St. Patrick



Enrolment forms are required to be returned by 31st March 2021.


NAPLAN


