Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Over the last month I have had the pleasure of conducting zoom interviews for Kindergarten for 2022. It was wonderful meeting so many new families who will soon become members of our community here at St Patrick's Primary School Parramatta.

The process of finding the 'right' school for a family can be very stressful from what I understand. I have a few young friends whose children are only 3 and they are already thinking about their options and they are asking questions about their local schools. When I ask them what is the important criteria for them the common responses are: that it is a Catholic School first and foremost and then the quality of education provided and as importantly, the nurturing the children will receive i.e. caring teachers.

When speaking to our new parents they expressed how lucky they felt to be able to enrol their little boy or girls. They asked about religious education, sacramental and liturgical opportunities and how Catholic Values are very important to them.

Other commonly articulated reasons for wishing to enrol their child at St Patrick's Parramatta included; the outstanding reputation the school holds amongst the local and extended communities, the high standard of education, the good behaviour expected from and displayed by the students, the valued history and connection they may have had with the school and the friendly, hospitable and close community the school is renowned for. The comment was often, "We hear so many good things about the school and we want our child to be part of a school such as this." As principal it was gratifying to hear all these positives associated with the school from new and existing parents and for this I thank the staff, children and you the parents who have always been extremely supportive, give valuable feedback and suggestions and value education.

What I particularly enjoyed throughout the interviews was meeting some of the little ones who delighted me with their individual responses and how they managed the zoom experience. I am reminded about how unique each little one is and I could see, on the parents' faces, how watching their child interact gave them such joy and filled them with wonderment. This was later supported by actually being able to meet them at their orientation session. It was so impressive seeing them accompany the teachers up to the library to have a play. Many of them looked so comfortable with the whole experience and some even delighted us by playing a running game with their newly found friends.

Please keep all families, who have children commencing Kindergarten, in your thoughts and prayers as they prepare for 2022.

	<u>GRADUATION MASS</u> , will be held outside in the school COLA for Year 6 students. Father Robert will be presiding. Certificates and candles to be presented.
	NB: By this date, the school will be able to invite one fully vaccinated Year 6 family member or friend onsite to participate in the Graduation Mass. Registration will be compulsory. Schools are required to see the Vaccination status of all visitors. Details to come.
	The school is committed to support all families by making accommodations for unvaccinated parents by live steaming the event if possible.
	<u>YEAR 6 PRESENTATION OF GIFT TO THE SCHOOL</u> will be held in front of Kindergarten to Year 5 students. Students in K-5 will be seated in their cohorts and socially distanced according to guidelines provided by NSW Health and CSNSW.
	<u>FAREWELL CEREMONY FOR YEAR 6, including the final bell and traditional throwing</u> of school hats, will take place at the end of the presentation of the gift, in front of the whole school and parent visitors. This will replace the last day of school celebrations (15th December) to minimize risk for all families.
	Dismissal as usual with no visitors on site will take place on December 15th.
	Students and their siblings will be permitted to leave to continue their celebrations in a hospitality venue of their choice. (This is optional as school is opened)






