Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Last Sunday was the first Sunday of the season of Advent, a time of preparation for the birth of our Lord Jesus, on Christmas Day. Pope Francis describes Advent as 'the period that every year introduces us to Christmas and its Mystery.',



This year, in his <u>address to participants in the Christmas Contest initiative</u>. His Holy Father muses that the Christmas lights have been somewhat dimmed due to the sadness and challenge of the pandemic. He calls all people, especially the youth to not lose hope. He explains that, 'The feast of the Birth of Christ is not out of tune with the trial we are going through, because it is the quintessential feast of compassion, the feast of tenderness. Its beauty is humble and full of human warmth.' What beautiful words, ones that remind us that there have always been challenges, right throughout human history and that people have an enormous capacity to rise above them if we work together in unity and not division.

Pope Francis also quotes the words of <u>Saint Paul VI</u>: "This world in which we live needs beauty in order not to sink into despair" [3]. Which beauty? Not the false one, made of appearances and earthly riches, which is hollow and a generator of emptiness. No. But that of a God made flesh, the one of faces- the beauty of faces, the beauty of stories; that of the creatures that make up our common home and which – as Saint Francis teaches us – participate in the praise of the Most High.

This Advent 2021 let us rise to the challenge set by Pope Francis by continuing to extend to other little acts of kindness. These do not have to be elaborate, but small and genuine. Let us see the faces of others first before we judge them. Let us try to understand their stories and show patience and human warmth.

'The beauty of Christmas shines through in the sharing of small gestures of genuine love. It is not alienating, it is not superficial, it is not evasive; on the contrary, it expands the heart, opening it up to gratuitousness – gratuitousness, a word artists understand well! – to the giving of self, and can also generate cultural, social and educational dynamics.'

	YEAR 6 PRESENTATION OF GIFT TO THE SCHOOL will be held in front of Kindergarten to Year 5 students. Students in K-5 will be seated in their cohorts and socially distanced according to guidelines provided by NSW Health and CSNSW.
	FAREWELL CEREMONY FOR YEAR 6, including the final bell and traditional throwing of school hats, will take place at the end of the presentation of the gift, in front of the whole school and parent visitors. This will replace the last day of school celebrations (15th December) to minimize risk for all families.




Dashboard


